Without advertising or even having our number in the phone book, we have been operating at full capacity and unfortunately turning away potential clients due to a lack of space and a lack of staffing necessary to aid those who contact us searching for help. In order for us to meet the demands we must find a larger location and increase staffing.

## Who We Are

CCC was developed as part of a natural progression of the “Corson Cares” and “Choose to be a Champion” models developed by Dr. Warren Corson III in response to the need for affordable, high quality counseling services provided by highly trained, highly skilled, and caring clinical professionals.

Dr. Warren saw that although there were very limited services offered in the Bristol area, these services are often available only to those with full medical insurance and an ability to pay.

There is a need for mental health services that employ a behavioral based approach. Dr. Warren also recognized that many individuals lack proper insurance and funds required for traditional programming and set about to open a community supported program that would be open to most.\*

Incorporated in 2005, CCC has served hundreds of individuals and families by assisting them in rebuilding their lives. CCC believes in the need for community involvement and assists many organizations through consultation and referrals. This networking and collaboration has helped our clients gain access to many other types of social service supports.

CCC is currently expanding our outreach programming through increasing presentations geared towards clients as well as through presenting our model of programming to the general public.



## The Cost of the Campaign

The Harbinger of Hope Campaign is designed to be a onetime campaign that will enable Doc Warren and CCC to implement and sustain these programs without the need for continual support campaigns. Our goal is to reach 5 million dollars in support. These funds will pay for a new location, remodeling, maintenance and additional staffing for new programming. The remaining funds will be placed in our endowment fund to offset future expenses.
